



May 2022 Elections

1. May 7, 2022 – Municipal Election. Early Voting April 25th – May 3rd

- Conducted by the City separately from the Constitutional and School elections.
- Early Voting at Girl Scout Cabin, 202 W. Austin St.
- Election day at Middle School Library, 110 W. Travis St.
- Mayoral seat plus two city council positions are on the ballot
- Look for city announcements
- Must be registered by April 7th to vote

2. May 7, 2022 – Constitutional Election & School Board and School Bond Elections. Early Voting April 25th – May 3rd

- Gillespie County Election Administrator conducts the election along with the Constitutional election
- There will be one ballot for constitutional and school elections as applied to each precincts
- Early Voting at Election Administration, 95 Frederick Rd – See Table (Item 4) for election day precinct voting locations
- Two propositions are on the ballot.
 - Prop 1 – Allows Texas Legislator to lower the school property taxes on elderly and disabled homeowners
 - Prop 2 – Increase school property tax homestead exemptions from \$25,000 to \$40,000
- Voter to decide school board members (2 seats), and \$82M middle school bond election
- Must be registered by April 7th to vote

3. May 24, 2022 – Runoff Election. Early Voting May 16 – 20th

- Republican State & local County precinct chairs are on the ballot
- State election winners will meet Democrat candidates in the general election in November 8, 2022
- Precinct chairs will be elected per “Plurality” – no further runoff. One with highest vote wins
- Early Voting at Election Administration, 95 Frederick Rd – See Table (Item 4) for election day precinct voting locations
- Anyone registered to vote by April 25th can participate.
- If you voted in one party’s primary, you cannot vote in the other party’s runoff.
- If you did not vote in the primary, you can still vote in the runoff election.
