

Resolution to Ban County-Wide Polling in Gillespie County

WHEREAS, the integrity and security of our elections are of the utmost importance to ensuring public trust and confidence in the electoral process; and

WHEREAS, county-wide polling locations require the use of electronic poll books which have a documented history of malfunctions, security vulnerabilities, and system failures; and


WHEREAS, county-wide polling has led to concerns regarding the secrecy of the ballot, as centralized voter check-in processes and electronic systems create opportunities for data exposure and tracking; and

WHEREAS, traditional precinct-based voting ensures greater election integrity by allowing voters to cast ballots within their designated precincts, reducing reliance on vulnerable electronic systems, minimizing ballot secrecy concerns, and preserving the localized accountability of election officials.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Republican Party of Gillespie County calls for an immediate ban to county-wide polling in Gillespie County and to maintain precinct-based voting locations to ensure election security, safeguard voter privacy, and restore confidence in the electoral process.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Republican Party of Gillespie County urges the Gillespie County Commissioners Court and the Texas Legislature to take all necessary legislative and regulatory actions to prohibit the use of county-wide polling and mandate continuance of precinct-based voting.
